PARK REPORT

What a year! It was nice to finally see a *somewhat* normal year at Rib Mountain. The Gathering Space, Visitor Station, and tower opened back up to the public, we could hold weddings and events once again in the amphitheater, and the Friend's concession stand opened its doors during fall weekends. Yet, the pandemic held its tight grasp and it wasn't a completely normal season, and I have yet to see my first concert in the clouds which I know to be so popular.

While we didn't have quite the heavy visitation that we saw in 2020, the park still saw a substantial increase in park visitors from 2019 – up a whopping 46% from our attendance counter and estimates. While this increase in usage has provided the park with some minor challenges, above all it has been great to see more folks getting outdoors and enjoying the park in their free time. That's why we're here, after all.

Over the past twelve months, we have been able to get a few notable things done. We were finally able to see the new playground installment completed – from tree clearing to grass seeding -- after project delays due to Covid, updating and installing new interpretive panels on the western trails (another Friends donation), resurfacing the rough western section of Park Road, repairing swaths of the Yellow Trail which were impacted with washouts from heavy August rains, as well as lots of planning for upcoming capital development, Eagle Scout, and maintenance projects planned in the park for 2022.

A huge thank you to all of the volunteers, Friends members and staff for all of the work involved in having another successful and busy year at Rib! I am looking forward to see what 2022 brings to the park.

FROM THE PRESIDENT

You'll remember that as 2021 began we were still very much restricted by COVID and knowing we would not be able to host the candlelight snowshoe events a group of Board members offered to maintain a groomed snowshoe trail that visitors could use safely on their own time.

We continuously evaluated when to safely begin various events - starting the year having our meetings virtually, revisiting our committees (virtually) to review and document what has been done in the past, recently, and discuss new ideas, and adding a Maps page to our website.

Slowly things began to trend toward normal with some outdoor events resuming, meeting in person outdoors, and eventually almost all restrictions were lifted. However some things just didn't come together as easily or as quickly as we had hoped to be able to get them to happen this year and so we missed out on some of our typical nature programs and the summer Concerts.

As for what we did accomplish, a special thank you goes to the Wausau Bird Club, namely Susan Haug and Myles Hurlburt, for leading us on our birding hike. Thank you to Kevin Keeffe, Bill Bursaw, and Bayli Christorf for their efforts in the reconstruction of the playground at the upper picnic area (read more about this project in this newsletter), and to everyone who helped with the reopening of the concession stand in the fall.

As we hope for an even better 2022, we ask you all to stay tuned to the master planning project and provide your input during the public comment periods. Thank you all for supporting the Friends of Rib Mountain!

FRIENDS PLAY-GROUND PROJECT

The Friends organization announces a completion of the playground in the upper park area near the observation tower and Friends concession shop. The existing equipment, installed over 40 years ago had fallen into disrepair, and consequently was removed. The new playground provides for younger children a safe and enjoyable alternative to other park play options.

The design and placement of equipment takes advantage of the site's Northward view of the Wausau area, and thinning of some vegetation further enhanced the experience and safety for playground users.

Installation happened during the past summer with a dedication in August. Friends members and other volunteers contributed time and energy to this exciting park addition, and for that we are grateful

Your donation of \$25, \$50, \$100, \$250, or whatever amount you feel comfortable giving, will benefit the park and park visitors for years to come.


